### Raffle tickets

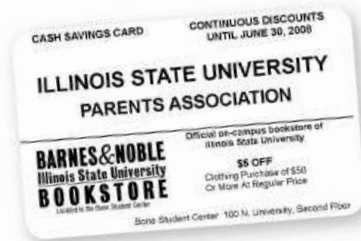
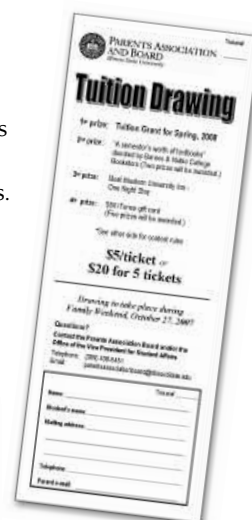

# Helping your student with career planning

The Career Center is a valuable central resource for Illinois State students, alumni, faculty, and a wide variety of employers in search of well-prepared candidates. The Career Center staff assists students in deciding on a major and the exploration of



satisfying career opportunities that match their talents, interests, and goals. The staff also helps individuals to develop job-search skills in order to pursue full-time positions, internships/cooperative education opportunities, and part-time jobs. The Career Center staff encourages parents to work in partnership with their son or daughter throughout college to help their student be successful in reaching academic and professional career goals.

Below is a suggested four-year plan for you to refer to as you encourage your student to participate in various activities while in college. These activities will ultimately help prepare your student for the job search at the end of his or her college experience.

## CAREER PLANNING: A FOUR-YEAR PROCESS

### First year

- Develop/refine time management skills. Understand your best learning style. Attend seminars presented by the University Center for Learning Assistance (UCLA).
- Set academic goals—grades are important.
- Ask for help EARLY if you need it. Tutors are available through many departments and individually through the UCLA. Use your professors' office hours to ask questions or communicate via e-mail!
- Get involved.  
*Suggestions: Professional organizations, community service, student government, residence hall government, social organizations, etc.*

- Employers will be more interested in you if you develop effective strong interpersonal and communication skills.
- Start researching careers.
- Employers prefer candidates who are able to articulate short-term goals (at least), and preferably longer-term goals. This is a process that deserves a lot of thought and consideration.  
*Suggestions: Attend department events and speakers, read professional journals, talk to faculty, take tours of the industry, attend career fairs, go to the Career Center (185 Student Services Building, 438-2200), etc.*
- Start your professional portfolio.
- Keep track of all your accomplishments in and outside the classroom.  
*Suggestions: Save any certificates, letters, and special academic projects that document your involvement.*

## Second year

- Meet early in the fall with your academic advisor to plan your schedule and discuss the best options for your choice of major.
- Continue/complete long-term planning with your academic advisor.
- Join a professional organization.
- Start to develop a network of faculty and friends. Continue to strengthen interpersonal skills. Begin to consider who will be your references when you graduate.
- Continue career exploration.
- Take advantage of internship or externship programs. Conduct informational interviews with professionals to help you focus on a specific career.
- Learn how to build an effective resume.
- Contact or visit the Career Center and find out how to put your resume on eRecruiting.com!  
*Suggestions: Use your professional portfolio as a reference and keep updating it.*

## Third year

- Develop your leadership skills.  
*Suggestions: Run for a position in your student organization, chair a committee, organize an event, supervise a project, etc.*
- Continue to network with peers, faculty, and professionals in your field.  
*Suggestions: Career fairs, the Professional Etiquette Presentation and Networking Event, and professional organizations often have “mixing” socials with employer representatives.*
- Look for internships or related work experience.
- All departments offer internship opportunities. Each program has an internship and/or clinical or field experience coordinator for you to talk to regarding GPA requirements, course credit, etc. Contact the Career Center for additional internship contact information. Check eRecruiting.com for available internship opportunities.  
*Suggestions: Find an internship related to your field of interest! Employers prefer students who graduate with some experience. Bring several copies of your resume to the employment and internship fair and practice your networking skills!*
- Learn how to conduct a well-planned job search.

- Resources are available in the Career Center Office (185 Student Services Building, 438-2200, and on the Web at [www.CareerCenter.ilstu.edu](http://www.CareerCenter.ilstu.edu)).
- Ask for a FREE Student Progress Summary at the Registration Office in Moulton Hall—this will tell you what requirements you still have to complete in order to graduate!
- Participate in career or job fairs in advance of your senior year.

## Fourth year

- Register with or update your information on the Career Center's eRecruiting.com.
- Make sure your resume is online through eRecruiting.com by September. If you want to participate in campus interviews, you MUST be registered!
- Review your graduation plan with your academic advisor.
- Polish up your job-search skills.
- Keep your resume updated, practice your interviewing skills, strengthen your network, and ask for letters of recommendation! Mock interviews can be scheduled at the Career Center. Check eRecruiting.com for job posting and on-campus interviews.
- Attend the employment and internship fairs and/or other fairs, depending on your major and job objective.  
*Suggestions: Dress professionally and bring several copies of your resume!*
- File your application for graduation in the Office of Undergraduate Evaluations. (Note the deadline listed in the Course Registration Directory.)

**Redbird Football: Illinois State vs. Western Illinois  
Hancock Stadium**

Head coach Denver Johnson is in his eighth season at Illinois State, while the nationally-ranked Redbirds are led by seniors Luke Drone and Kye Stewart. Drone is on pace to become the most prolific passer in Redbird history and is among only 16 players in the country to be considered on the watch list for the Walter Payton Award, which is presented to the top offensive player at the Division I Football Championship subdivision level. Stewart, the top returning tackler in the Gateway Football Conference, is the preseason favorite to claim the league's Defensive Player of the Year Award, a honor that a Redbird has received in each of the last five seasons. He is also among 16 players nationally to be considered for the 2007 Buck Buchanan Award, an accolade presented to the top FCS defender. The ISU-Western Illinois game is a storied in-state rivalry, so pick up the tickets early, bring the family, Spread the Red and be a part of Family Weekend.
